

Three countries - Three contests - One winner

By visiting our three F2A and F2D World Cup contests you do not only score points for the World Cup but also compete in the "Super-Dreiländerpokal 2011".

2011 will be an anniversary for the Dreiländerpokal (5th year in a row). We will celebrate this by having a Super-Dreiländerpokal with all three contests within 9 days. It will start in Sweden on Saturday-Sunday (28-29th of May), continue in Denmark on Wednesday-Thursday (1-2nd of June) and finish in Germany on Saturday-Sunday (4-5th of June).

This is the first time in the C/L history there will be three World Cups so close in time allowing pilots (and others) to join without having to spend too many vacation days! We only plan to do it like this one time and no more so attending will be something to tell your grandchildren......

Pilots flying all three events will have their World Cup points added and trophies will be awarded to the ones with the three highest scores in each class. All pilots competing in at least two of the contests will receive a Dreiländerpokal Diploma.

To be able to finish each contest in two days we must have an entrance limit of 25 pilots in F2A and 50 pilots in F2D.
